

HOA collecting tubes for ants (3x)

Our *HOA collecting tubes* are made of sturdy plastic and an aluminium lid with a large hole, capped by a stainless-steel mesh. It can be used for all kinds and sizes of ant queens. The tubes are highly durable and can be used for many years. Claustral ants (such as sugar ants) can even be bred in it. (For semi-claustral ants, such as bull ants, HOA offers specially designed breeding farms.)

The tubes come with snug-fitting foam tubing for temperature and light protection and with six cotton wool pieces for water storage. These water buffers, in combination with the foam tubing, additionally the temperature.

tip:

- Use the water storage while collecting ants to prevent dehydration of the ant queen.
- Glass tubes are not recommended due to the high risk of breakage.
- Never leave the house without a collecting tube in case you have a chance encounter with a precious ant queen! 😉

material list:

- 3x collecting/breeding tubes with lids
- 3x snug-fitting foam tubing
- 6x cotton wool pieces



setup:

1. Fill the tube up to the top with clean water.

2. Squash one cotton wool piece into a ball and and push it into the tube.

3. Push the cotton wool ball with your finger or a slim stick down to the middle of the tube.

4. Get rid of the excess water in the front part of the tube. It is now ready for use.
